Arthur Scott Selfe, also known as Scotty, passed away peacefully on March 4, 2021 at Heritage Hall, Clintwood. Scotty was 64 and lifelong resident of Dickenson County. He was a member of Clintwood Baptist Church. Scotty was preceded in death by his parents, Arthur and Frankie (Mullins) Selfe; his sister, Melissa Slone; his maternal grandparents, Newton and Lura Mullins; his paternal grandparents, Joe and Vesta Selfe; and his great nephew, Jacob Crotty.

Scotty made friends wherever he was and loved joking around. He perfected the art of loafing. With the many friends and acquaintances, he had made over the years, no matter where he went there was someone to chat with and catch up. A fixture of the Clintwood community, he was frequently seen at Clintwood High School football and basketball games and community events. He was a longtime member of the Clintwood Volunteer Fire Department and assisted the Virginia Forestry Service, where he enjoyed both contributing to the safety of the community as well as the brotherhood that provided, spending many evenings enjoying Bingo night.

Scotty retired from the Dickenson County School System as janitor in 2014. Prior to that he worked for many years at M&M Transfer Co. where he had the opportunity to travel around much of the United States in a way that most of us only dream of. He previously worked at Lee-Lynn Mfg.

Scotty was a devoted son, brother, nephew, and uncle. He leaves behind two sisters: Brenda Reynolds (Jimmy), and Gwen Edwards (Mike); 3 nephews, Mathew Reynolds, Wes Slone, and Jordan Slone, and 3 nieces, Stephanie Crotty, Asheligh Edwards, and Katie Stiltner; 12 great nieces and nephews; a brother-in-law, Donald Slone; and 7 aunts and uncles.

He has been missed by many this last year and a half that he had to be in Heritage Hall and will continue to be missed. Many thanks to Heritage Hall in Clintwood for being his family during COVID lockdown.

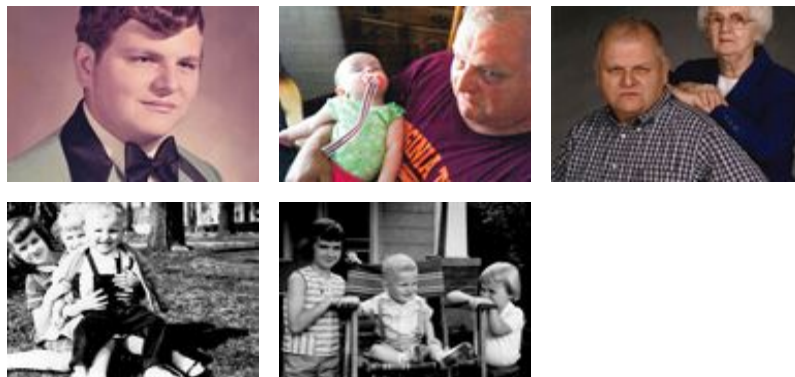
