Bradley O'Neil Goins, age 76, relocated to his heavenly home Friday, April 6, 2018, peacefully in his sleep on Goins Fork. He was a 1960 graduate of Clintwood High School. He was a very proud member of Clintwood Baptist Church where he served as a Deacon through the '80s. Bradley was a Veteran of the United States Air Force serving 1961-1969 including a tour in Vietnam as a hydraulic mechanic working on aircraft. He met Dorothy Foster on May 19, 1962 and married her on November 9, 1962. Their 1st child, Michael, was born 1964; their 2nd, Rusty in 1966; James in 1973 and Kara in 1975. He was active with the Clintwood Greenwave Booster Club, coaching in the community and always a prominent member of any group maintaining the CHS FieldHouse. 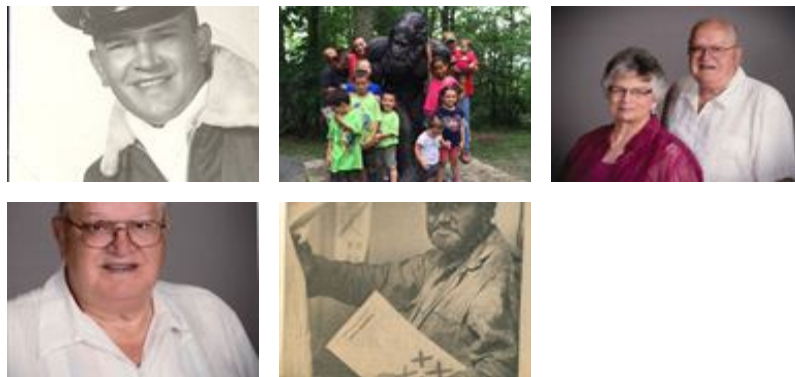
