On May 4, 2026, Clyde Shatley Jr. passed away peacefully while under the care of the compassionate staff at the Bluegrass Hospice Care Center in Lexington, Kentucky. Clyde was born on February 22, 1957.

Clyde was a hardworking man, dedicating forty-three years to the coal mines before he fell ill with black lung. He enjoyed outdoor mechanical activities, often spending hours in his garage working on his vehicles.

Clyde was preceded in death by his eldest son, Robert Shatley, his mother, Willow Dean Shatley, and his father, Clyde Shatley Sr.

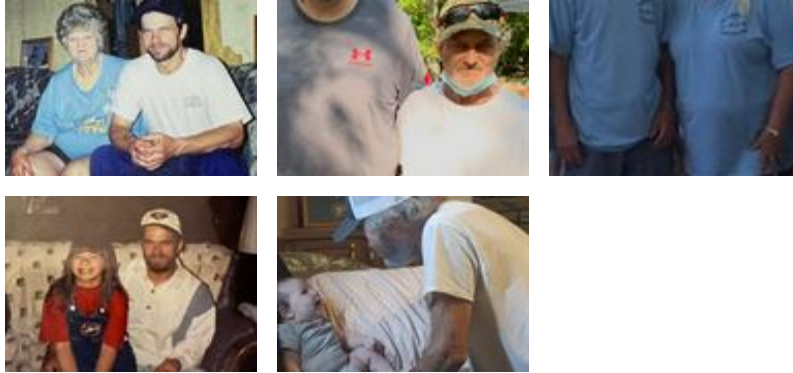
