Fred Farmer, 101, of Clintwood, Virginia, passed away Friday, October 13, 2017, at his son and daughter-in-law's home in Harpers Ferry, West Virginia, where he resided for the past two years. Born September 19, 1916, he was the son of the late Bruce and Dolly Farmer. He was a member of the Pound River Church of the Brethren.
