Joyce Wright Graham, age 78, passed away Monday, November 15, 2021 at Dickenson Community Hospital. She was born in Bridgewater, Virginia and was a member of The Teacher's Society, Delta Kappa Gamma. Mrs. Graham was a member of the Bridgewater Church of the Brethren and was a former girl scout leader for several years. She had resided in Dickenson County since 1969 and was a graduate of Radford University. She began teaching in Dickenson County on July 1, 1969 and retired on July 1, 2000. 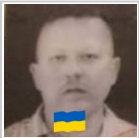
