Julie C. Allie of Vinton, VA passed away October 17, 2024 at the age of 79.

Julie was an energetic and beautiful young woman who modeled for department stores in her teen years. She quickly realized she was happier outside surrounded by horses and dogs than on a runway. She ran horse training and boarding farms in McLean and Bonsack, VA for 11 years while also starting a family. After leaving the farm, she was a real estate agent and right of way agent in VA and NC. She then enrolled at Hollins University as an adult in their Horizon program, a gutsy move that demonstrated her strength and determination as a single mother with her youngest in elementary school. After earning her Sociology degree, she went to work with the Roanoke City Child Welfare Office in the Child Protection Services unit where she remained until retirement. In retirement, she returned to her comfort zone, buying a small farm with dogs, horses, goats and swans.

Julie is survived by her children: son Davis W. Lincoln of Roanoke, daughter and son in law Katrina L. and Chris Koon of Harrisburg NC and son, Robert W. Allie of Roanoke; six grandchildren Austin Lincoln, Ryan Lincoln, Rylee Lincoln, Graham Lincoln, Karsyn Koon and Aiden Koon; and her brother Gene C. Muddiman. Julie is preceded in death by her parents, Harry "Mudd" and Claudine Muddiman, sister-in-law Mary Ann Muddiman and many beloved aunts, uncles and cousins.
