“Wade, it is so hard to believe that you are gone..how do you say goodbye to someone you have grown up with your whole life? From as early as i can remember, it was me, you, and Nicole together. From playing outside in the dirt, to riding the heck out of your Kawasaki 75 motorcycle, to trying to make mud pies in the mud holes and looking for that big ole bull frog that lived in the ditch in Mammaw and Pappaw's driveway..if we weren't at Mammaw's house then you were at ours, but we had each other to play with and look out for each other..but time moves on, we grew up, but we looked out for one another, even after graduation..there has never been a time that if i needed someone to talk to or have my back, you were there..and i had yours..my kids loved seeing you and if they saw you when i wasn't with them, that is the first thing they told me when they got home..Aidan wanted to show you how well he can ride his Kawasaki 65 dirt bike because i told him and Ivy all about how we learned to ride a motorcycle on yours and how we would take turns on it, riding it as long as possible all over "the flats" or until the gas tank was dry! I could go on and on with so many fond memories and all the fun times we had growing up, us "3 amigos"..then we had Rather and Chandra to join us..there was never a dull moment when we were together..all the times we made Pappaw so mad that he would come after us but we would either run off of the carport or run behind the kitchen table and grab ahold of mammaw hollering "help mammaw, pappaw is trying to get us!" She would turn around and fuss at pappaw and say "Now Bennie, You leave those kids alone!" We knew we were safe then cause he couldn't get us as long as couldn't get his wheelchair to where our "safe spots" were.. Wade had a heart of gold. He was a little on the shy side if he didn't know you but if you got to be his friend, you had a friend for life..When i was in the hospital at NCH ICU waiting on the ambulance to come pick me up to transfer me to HVMC ICU, feeling depressed and homesick, i fell asleep..i was awakened to a soft voice saying "Celeste..Celeste is that you? Hey Celeste r u ok?" I thought at first i was dreaming about Uncle Wade visiting me until i rolled my head



*to the side of the voice and when i opened my eyes, there stood Wade, grinning and i said, "Wade i thought i was dreaming.." and he just chuckled and asked how i was feeling..made me feel better that he, out of all my family, thought enough to come visit me and check in to see if i was ok..and if i needed him to get me anything at all..but that was Wade..he loved his family and he loved his dogs..he had a hard life at times, so did i..we both had struggles along the same lines so we could relate to each other..Wade was more than an uncle to me and my kids, i thought of him as a brother..we started out in this life together, grew up together, and were still there for each other now...a kind hearted soul but yet he had that"Mullins didn't care to tell you what he thought about something" either mentality..we were 2 peas in a pod..it feels like i have not only lost an Uncle, a friend, but a piece of me too..you will be missed dearly Wade but i can tell you, you will never be forgotten and you will always be close to our hearts and in our thoughts..tomorrow isn't promised to anyone but i never thought you would be leaving us this soon, way to soon..please watch over the rest of us here on Earth and save me a spot in Heaven..until then Wade, you are forever in our hearts and memories and we will always love you..RIP Wade and in the words of Hardy, "Hold it down till i get there, but till then, give Heaven some Hell!!" 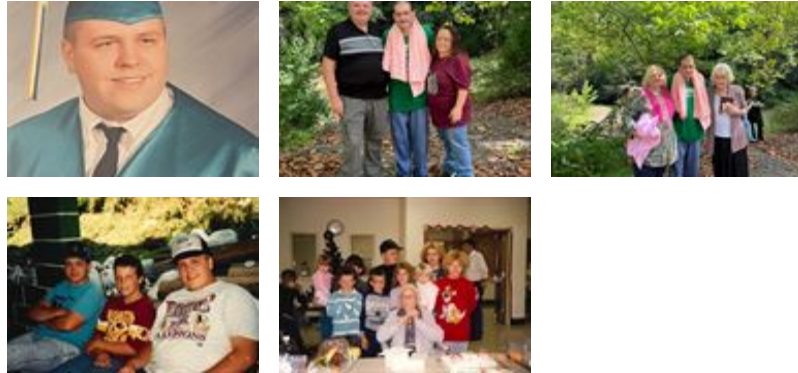

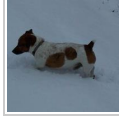
