Mack Phipps passed away peacefully on February 26th, 2024 under the care of a devoted medical team at Bristol Regional Medical Center after a series of declining symptoms that resulted from a fall in December.

He was a loving husband, father, and grandfather; a gifted and witty storyteller, avid and lifelong hunter, fisherman, and baseball enthusiast.

Mack, born on February 24th, 1937, was a lifelong resident of Dickenson County, living primarily on Brush Creek all of his life. He talked often of the “good ole days” spent at the Bear Pen schoolhouse in the 40s and 50s. He enjoyed the slow simplicities of life and took pride in being a provider for his family through his dedicated work at the Clintwood Farm Store, Clintwood Sewing Factory, and Cumberland Collieries.

He loved to squirrel and coon hunt in his younger years. He owned several good hunting dogs over the years, with queen being his favorite. Later in life, he enjoyed turkey and deer hunting. He was a proud member of Tivis Chapel Church and was baptized by his brothers in 2012.

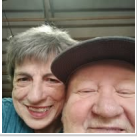
