Roy Mullins, age 87, passed away Sunday, July 10, 2022 at Holston Valley Medical Center. He was a lifelong resident of Dickenson County and also a businessman and owner of Lee-Lynn Manufacturing, also delivered propane gas, and owner of M and M Transfer. He was a deacon of Flemingtown Freewill Baptist Church. Mr. Mullins was also a 50-year member of Masonic Lodge #66 the first member of the Clintwood Lion's Club a previous member of the County Planning Commission and the Dickenson County Hospital Board. He volunteered with the Dickenson County 4H Program and worked for the Virginia Forestry Department where he served as Smokey the Bear for Dickenson County Schools. Mr. Mullins was on the Dickenson County Chamber of Commerce Board and had recently received a certificate of recognition. 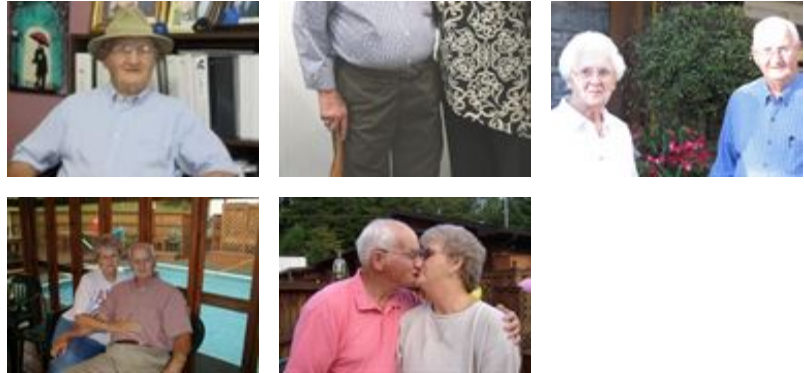

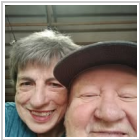
